<b>SUBJECT:</b>	<b>Chairman's report</b>

1. On June 25<sup>th</sup> I accompanied the District Manager in restarting Strawberry View well site. The well is producing approximately 30 gallons per minute, reducing the need for pumping water from Pine to Strawberry. The steel tank was replaced with 2 modern reduced maintenance plastic tanks.
2. The District Manager and I attended County rezoning meeting at the request of a citizen to answer any questions about water supply to the new development. The county did not allow questions of us nor did PSWID make any comments.
3. The recent water conservation requirements were implemented by PSWID because the shallow well sources levels have fallen due to the drought, in one case by 50 feet. Staff is gathering additional data on all of our wells at this time. The situation was resolved by putting motor savers on the wells that were losing suction.
4. We are researching the possibility of developing a deep well in Strawberry at the recommendation of Mr. Weeks. A deep-water source in the Strawberry canyon would provide us with a more reliable source without pumping water from Pine.
5. Attended the WIFA construction meeting with EUSI. Mr. Hendricks will present the information on the meeting.
