BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION: WIFA FINANCIAL AID PROGRAM(S)

WIFA Capital Program:

The District continues to process WIFA disbursements.

Implementing the Recommendations from the Preliminary Engineering Report (PER):

The Work Study Session related to the possible USDA loan/grant was rescheduled to 8-27-20 due to COVID-19 concerns.

The District is continuing the USDA application process.

Sunrise Engineering performed a site visit to make sure they understood the District and water system tp prepare the Environmental Assessment, which is a USDA requirement.

WIFA CAPITAL PROGRAM PLUS MISCELANEOUS DISTRICT CIP PROJECTS

- **Project Close Out Approval of Construction (AOC):** The District received the AOC for Canyon tanks. Still awaiting the AOC for Pinewood Haven. EPS submitted the paperwork to ADEQ 7/29/20.
- New Well:
 - Under a special USDA program, the District may be eligible as an emergency project, for a new deep well as it increases the reliability of water supply. Based upon the current demand verses the supply, the District should consider ways to increase water production capacity.

• Waterline Replacement:

- Based upon the current uncommitted funds, the District can replace with the Cool Pines Phase B & C waterline in Pine, which has been having numerous failures.
- WIFA has agreed that the proposed Cool Pines Phase B & C waterline replacement in Pine is an approved project without going to the WIFA Board at their October meeting. The Particular in the proposed project without going to the WIFA Board at their October meeting.
- The Board will consider approving a Task Order from MGC related to this project.

During the WIFA project meetings the overall WIFA project list and budgetary allocations are reviewed and updated.

- Provide and Install Radio Read Water Meters and Software
 - There are only 294 remaining to be replaced.
 - Meter Specialist tested the water production well metering and determined that the meters are accurate within AWWA standards.

- The District will now have to determine the next steps to address the nonrevenue/unaccounted for water and the difference between the production and sale of water.
- State Route 87 Bradshaw to MR Well Site Waterline
 - \circ MGC is finalizing the project for the new waterline on Highway 87.
- Strawberry Lane N Strawberry Drive E SR87 S Fossil Creek and
- Juniper-Tanner Ralls/Fossil Creek Wagon Wheel
 - Apache Underground has mobilized for the waterline replacement projects.
